

Another Kiwanian has passed from our midst. Word has reached us that **Linda Thurman** died on Wednesday, June 26 after suffering a stroke. Linda, a nurse at Shell before retiring, was the longest serving female member of our club, having joined May 12,1994. She served two terms as president 2001-02 and 2008-09. Her late husband **Herb Thurman**, a ranger at the John Muir historic site, was also a Kiwanian and served a term as president. Here is a message from her daughter Sandy:

"Linda Thurman's life came to a peaceful close on Thursday, June 26, but her spirit and legacy will live on. We find strength in knowing she's reunited with her husband, Herb, and that their love will continue to guide us. As we navigate this difficult time, we're grateful for the chance to celebrate her life and honor her memory.

Following her wishes, we will be gathering as a family to scatter her remains among the redwoods.


Grant Recipients Report
