All About The Foundation



The Martinez Kiwanis Foundation makes possible the Centennial Grant program that celebrates the club's 100th anniversary. Members of the Foundation recently approved a grant of up to \$10000 to the Boys and Girls Club for maintenance and similar expenses associated with the van recently donated to it.

At its December 4 meeting the members will consider approving a grant for "Phase 1" improvements to the clubhouse including cabinetry. Where did this Foundation come from? It all started with the Kiwanis Club of Concord which incorporated a foundation in 1973; rumor has it that the proceeds of sale of a house built by the club were the original source of funds. When the Concord club disbanded in 1987, it donated the funds to our club, and the name was changed to "The Martinez Kiwanis Foundation". Then original Martinez trustees were Robert Burgess, Cliff Egan, Johnn Davis, Carl Rush, and Bill Sharkey, all former club presidents whose pictures appear on the club wall.

By 2013 the foundation had assets of \$98000 which had grown to \$305000 by 2024. The foundation took on a new shape in 2015 when bylaws were amended to provide that all club members were foundation members and the club officers and directors also served the foundation. Then in late 2024, the foundation received a \$175000 bequest from the estate of late club member Bill Chase. Current assets are \$ 558000.

You can support the foundation by donating to "The Martinez Kiwanis Foundation", an IRC Section 501(c) (3) organization, so donations are tax deductible as permitted by law.

Supervisor Scales-Preston Speaks to Club



Shanelle Scales-Preston, District 5 county supervisor, spoke to the club on November 20. She described the efforts of the Board to deal with funding cutbacks from the federal government. She said the County is in sound financial shape with a large reserve fund.

Shanelle is a former Pittsburg city councilmember and is approaching one year's service on the Board of Supervisors. She represents a district which includes all of Martinez.

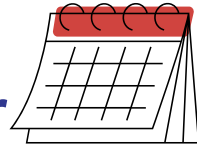
