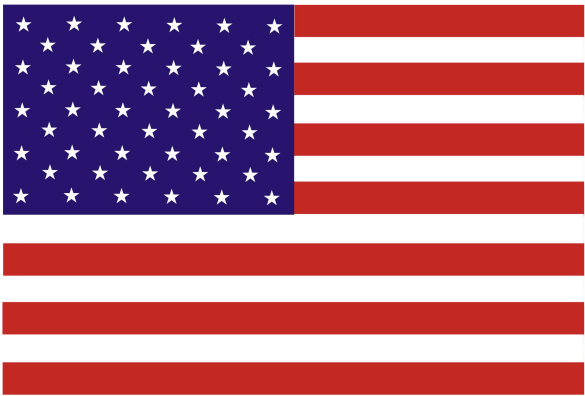

Three Important Dates

2026 will be a year to celebrate anniversaries. The Kiwanis Club of Martinez will celebrate its centennial on April 15, 2026, 100 years after the club was chartered by Kiwanis International.

The City of Martinez will celebrate its sesquicentennial on April 1, 2026, 150 years after its incorporation as a California city. A commemoration of the event will occur at a City Council meeting on that date, but a bigger celebration is being planned for August 29 at the marina.

A semiquincentennial celebration of the declaration of independence of the United States of America will occur on July 4, 2026, 250 years after the promulgation of the declaration (the declaration was actually approved by the second continental congress on July 2, 1776).

Centennial Grants Focus on Home

Centennial grants to mark the club's 100th birthday now focus on the club's home, the Kiwanis Youth Center. Members have already approved phase 1 improvements (mostly cabinetry) and will be asked to approve phase 2 (mostly flooring) at the January 8 meeting. The City of Martinez, owner of the building, has agreed to fund the purchase of giant screen TVs for the clubhouse and recently painted the exterior.

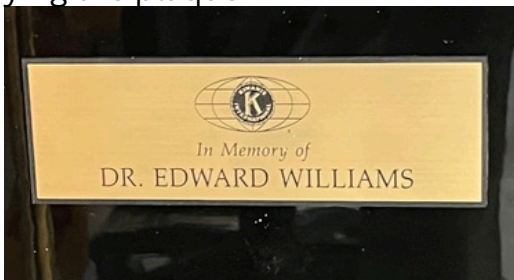

Treasurer/fundraiser chair **Patty Winsor** has a tentative report on the financial results: total sales were \$58183, cost of goods sold \$40309, other expenses \$558, net profit \$17316. She reports that total sales were affected by the short selling period, and unsold candy to be sold at meetings starting January 8 and some future bank charges will affect the final figures.

This fundraiser would not be possible without the efforts of every member who pitched in staffing the retail schedule, setting up and taking down the store, and a big hand for **Patty**!
